"I am the light of the world. The one who follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life." (John 8:12)

This past month, I read from someone who suggested, "If you can't tell someone how God has impacted your life over the past month, your relationship with God may not be as close as you think." That gave me real pause. Because it's easy to say that we follow Jesus and that we love God, while we continue living our lives in autopilot, living the way WE think is best. It has made me consider, "How am I following God on a day-to-day basis?"

As we begin a new year together, I'd invite you to consider how you are following God right now. If someone asked you, "What's one thing you've done in the last week because you felt led by God to do it?" What would you say?

Over the past few months, we've talked a lot about how God invites us to follow God in three directions: up, out, and in. We've learned that if we want to experience the fullness of the Jesus life, we're called to follow God in each of those three directions...not just the one direction that comes most naturally to us.

In the same way, we've seen how churches that flourish follow God in all three of those directions, too. In 2019, we want to make sure GBC is intentionally following God in all three directions. That will require your help! This year, we're going to be asking our church family to prayerfully consider ONE of those directions that they'll agree to serve in the church. We'll put together three teams: an UP team, an IN Team, and an OUT Team - and we're asking each person in our church family to pick one to serve on. The UP team will focus on helping connect our church family with God, focusing primarily on worship and education. The IN team will focus on developing a sense of caring and community within our church family. The OUT team will help us creatively bless our community (and the world) in Jesus' name. Your deacons will be talking with you more about this. Of course, we're not going to make anyone do anything. But we hope that God will lead you to commit to serve in one of those three areas for 2019. Because that is how the church functions...when it's people follow the way of Jesus.

That's a good thing. Because Jesus himself reminds us that when we follow him intentionally, we'll never walk in darkness. He promises to guide us. We'll have the light of life.
